

Taking a Closer Look

The Steiner Commander V binocular (top right) has soft, form-fitting eyecups. Not only were these rated comfortable by all testers, but they also eliminate sidelight and can be folded down when the user is wearing glasses. The Swarovski SLC7x50B (bottom left) is the only binocular *PS* tested that uses a roof prism; the other test units use porro prisms. Swarovski says the prism increases light gathering and sharpness. The Fujinon FMTRC-SX has diopter adjustments on each eyepiece (bottom right). This isn't *PS*'s preferred setup; however, testers found the Fuji's to be accurate and easy to use.
