

INTERIOR NOTES TIKI 30



Life aboard a Tiki 30 is simple. Most activities like cooking, reading, bathing, even sleeping take place in the large cockpit. A portable camp stove (top left) heats water for coffee. Just to the right of the stove is a small sink—and even it is made of epoxy-sealed plywood. The amas (below left) are fine for light gear, sails, and a guitar, but loading them with heavy tools and equipment can severely hinder the boat's sailing ability. The amas also provide berths at sea or in wet weather at anchor.
